Conference Overview

Thursday 10th October – Main Conference Day: Registration opens at 08:00, Main Conference begins promptly at 09:00 and ends at 17:00.

Morning session (technical panels) - Thursday 10th October 2019 09:00 hrs

The morning session will focus on **innovations in cement and concrete** and will be opened by Lars Sudmann, widely recognised for his TEDx talk “The Spaghetti Principle of Innovation.” Lars has in-depth experience in innovation leadership and works with companies such as Vodafone, the Microsoft Innovation Center, Knauf and Siemens. His opening presentation will set the tone for the interesting sessions on innovation in our sector.

Our cement and concrete panels will each bring together a wealth of expertise from academics, suppliers and practitioners on the innovations that will be central to the future of our industry. Afternoon session - Thursday 10th October 2019 14:00 hrs

The high-level afternoon plenary session will explore the **future of cities and the role of concrete** and will be led by world-renowned smart cities expert, Ayesha Khanna. Ayesha is a strategic advisor on smart cities and has worked with SMRT, Singapore's largest public transport company and SmartDubai transforming the city's service delivery. She has been published and quoted on innovation and smart cities in The New York Times, BusinessWeek, TIME, Newsweek, Forbes, and Harvard Business Review.

Ayesha will be joined by prominent Indian architect Dr Anupama Kundoo, Simon Gusah, Chief Resilience Officer for Lagos in Nigeria and Professor Erwin Viray, Head of the Architecture Sustainable Design Pillar, Singapore University of Technology & Design. They will explore themes around the future of cities and the role of concrete.

The 'Concrete in Life' awards dinner commences with drinks reception at 18:30 in the Wallich foyer (Etincelle Bar) - Gallery viewing commences at 19:00 followed by a seated dinner at 19:30.

Singapore Airport Information

Flights arrive into Changhi Airport. Transfer to the City centre by taxi, train or bus or you can book 4 and 7-seater transport with the concierge in the arrival's hall.

TAXI

Taxis are available for hire at the taxi stands in the Arrival areas of each Terminal. A ride to the city takes about 30 minutes and costs between S\$20 and S\$40. All fares are metered.

There is an additional Airport Surcharge for all trips originating from the Airport:

- Fri–Sun (5:00PM–12:00AM): S\$5 Airport Surcharge
- All other times: S\$3 Airport Surcharge
- Midnight surcharge (12:00 AM–6:00 AM): 50% of final metered fare
- Peak-hour surcharge (6:00 AM–9:30 AM, Mon–Fri and 6:00 PM–12:00 AM, Mon–Sun): 25% of final metered fare

TRAIN

To get to the city, take the train from Changi Airport MRT Station (CG2) to Tanah Merah MRT Station (EW4), then transfer to the East West Line 2 towards Tuas Link MRT Station (EW33).

Nearest MRT to hotel is Tanjong Pagar (2 minutes' walk to hotel)

Get detailed train timings on the **SMRT Journey Planner**.

Single-ride tickets and EZ-link cards can be purchased at all train stations.

AIRPORT TRANSFER

For convenient transfers from Changi Airport to your destination, please approach the 24-hour Ground Transport Concierges at the Arrival Halls. Choose from the two vehicle options below based on your needs.
